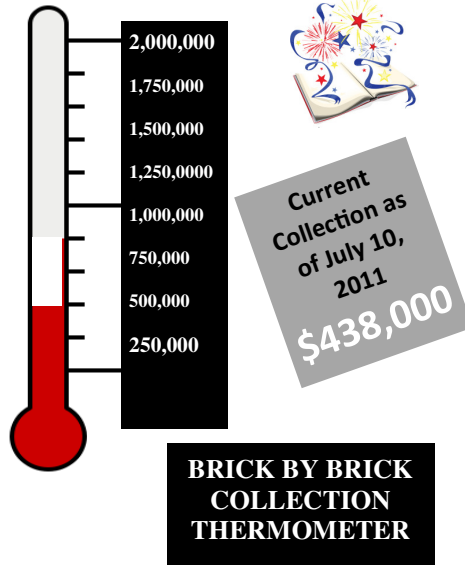


## Building Project Updates

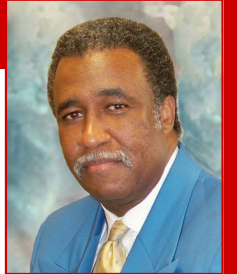

Anxiety

How can we quiet our fears and worries?

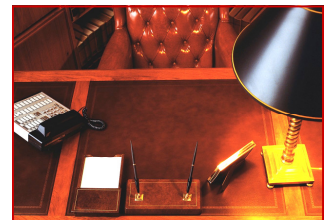
The answer is something like the new technology being developed to quiet noise in the workplace. Several companies now market headphones that emit what is called antinoise.

"The principle behind all antinoise devices is the same," writes Philip Elmer-Dewitt in Time. "Noise is basically a pressure wave traveling through the air. Antinoise is the mirror image of that wave, an equal and opposite vibration exactly 180 degrees out of phase with the noise to be blocked. When the noise and the antinoise collide, they interact with what is called destructive interference, canceling each other out."

Airport baggage handlers can now wear headphones equipped with a tiny microphone that "samples sound waves at the wearer's ear, processes them through special circuitry and broadcasts counter tones that cancel the offending sounds in midair. Result: silence or something close to it."

In the same way, we can cancel worries and fears with the antinoise of God's truth.
