Building Project Updates

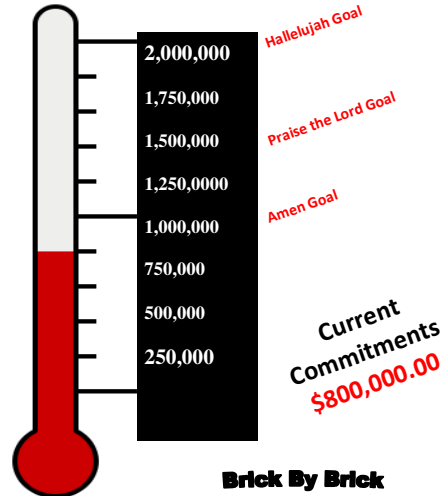
