Flea Markets

Flea markets are groups of booths, usually outdoors, that sell a variety of goods at discount prices. Where did the name come from? You might think that it refers to seedy, flea-bitten merchandise. But the word flea isn't a description-it's a mispronunciation.

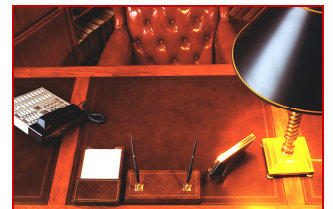
It started in New York at one of the first outdoor markets called the Vallie Market. A sign was made to help people find the location, but it turned out to be too small for the whole name to fit. The name was written as "Vle. Market." People started calling it the "vlee" market because that's what the abbreviation looked like. This was repeated until it sounded like *flea*. Now every open-air market is referred to by this strange label.

It's funny how even our most inconsequential actions can have such a big impact. The person who made the flea market sign probably never even thought twice about what he had written. He had no idea that years later people would refer to the abbreviation on his simple sign. You never know what little thing will turn out to be important.

That's why the Bible tells us, "...be a good workman, one who does not need to be ashamed..." Because one day God will examine your work: (2 Timothy 2:15.)

By keeping your eyes on the details, you will have the assurance that you did your best and created a lasting impression.

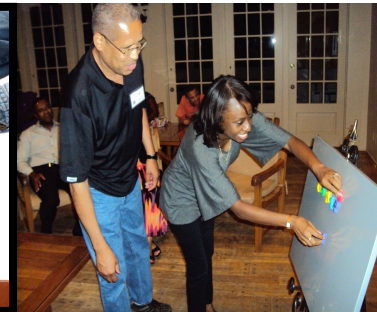
