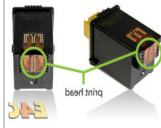

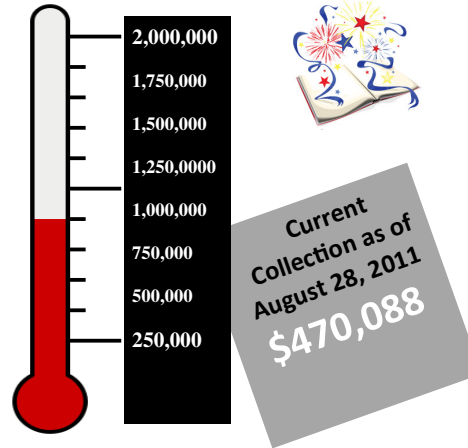
Building Project Updates
