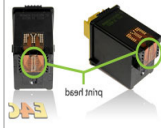

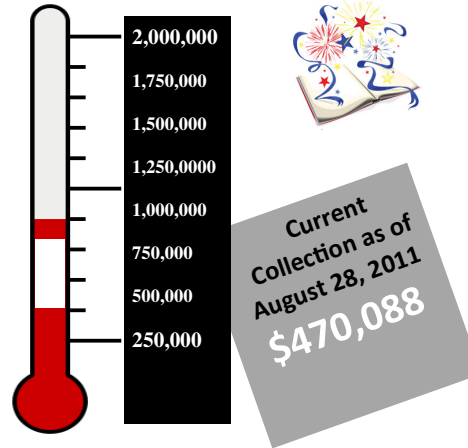
## Building Project Updates

**Prison Break**

A group of prisoners in Mexico were planning a daring, underground escape. They carefully calculated how far it would be to dig past the prison walls and secretly began working on a tunnel.

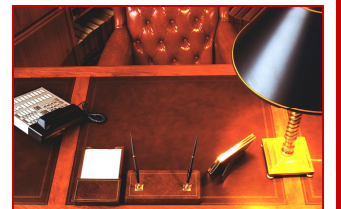

Everything went according to plan until the very last minute. As the escapees emerged, they realized that they had dug their tunnel directly into a courtroom.

It's a good guess that the prisoners wouldn't have gotten away with their escape, although justice was extremely swift in their case. We expect that people who do wrong intentionally will bring bad things on themselves.

That's one of the messages of the Bible. It says, "Do not those who plot evil go astray? But those who plan what is good find love and faithfulness" (Proverbs 14:22, NIV.)

The best way to avoid trouble is to dig into God's Word and steer clear of evil.
