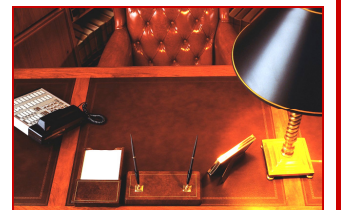
The Sum that is Always the Same

You'll need a pencil and paper for this exercise, but you'll probably find it intriguing enough to make the effort. This is the story of the "sum that's always the same." No matter how many times you try these few steps, you will always arrive at the same answer. Here's how it works:

1. Pick any three-digit number, making sure that the first digit is larger than the last (975, for example)
2. Reverse the number you picked (579)
3. Subtract the smaller number (579) from the larger number (975). If your calculations leave you with a two-digit number, like 99, add a zero to the beginning of the number (099).
4. Take the answer from step 3 (975-579=396) and reverse it (639).
5. Add together the answer for step 3 (396) and its reverse (639).
6. You will always end up with the number 1089

We like counting, perhaps, because it makes us feel that we have some control over things and that we can define them. But no one can define, count, or limit the goodness of God. His children say, "O Lord my God, many and many a time you have done great miracles for us, and we are ever in your thoughts. Who else can do such glorious things? No one else can be compared with you" (Psalm 40:5)
