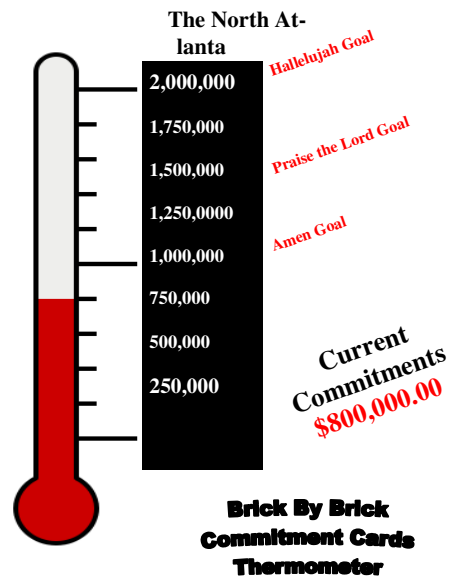


Building Project Updates

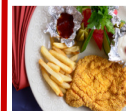
