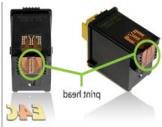

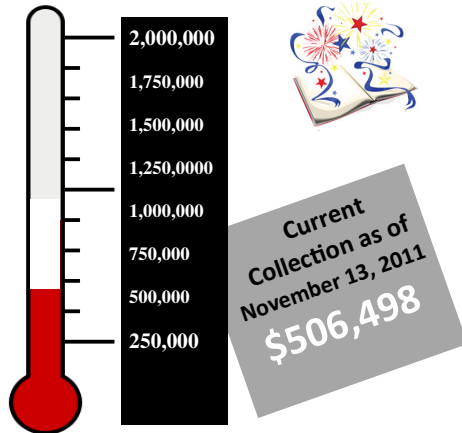

2 Thessalonians 3:5

May the Lord bring you into a deep understanding of the steadfastness of Christ.

Since I rack up frequent flyer miles, this story is especially meaningful to me. A passenger recently shared his experience on a flight from Atlanta to Ft. Lauderdale.

"It was delightful. We sailed high, in clear skies, with nary a bump to bother us. As the pilot announced our initial descent, things began to change," he said.

"The cloud cover in the area was thick, and we would have to go through it to land. As I peered out the window into murky grey emptiness, I felt frightened. There was nothing I could do except put my trust in the pilot and those in the control tower at Ft. Lauderdale," he continued.

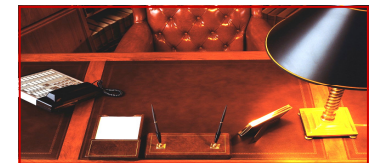
